EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW

AIRPORTS - the nearest domestic airport is Wanaka. It is approximately a 10 minute drive
The nearest international airport is Queenstown. It is approximately a 1 hour drive over the Crown Range or 1 hour 15 via Cromwell. Allow an additional 30 minutes for roadworks, weather or other hold ups.

BBQ is situated towards the rear of the property and available for your leisure. Please inquire at the reception desk for BBQ utensils and oil.

BLANKETS - there are extra blankets and pillows in your wardrobe. If you require any additional bedding please contact reception.

COFFEE & TEA facilities are provided in all rooms. If you would like a coffee plunger please ask at reception

COOKING – Cooking facilities are available in all our rooms. Please avoid cooking fish or other strongly scented foods that may linger. Extra charges may apply if the room cannot be used the following night due to lingering odors.

DAMAGE - The guest who has booked the room is liable for any damage or theft from the room or property. The cost of any damage to the room will be charged to the credit card on file.

DISHES - We kindly ask that you take responsibility for your dishes. Our housekeeping staff are dedicated to ensuring a clean, pleasant stay for all guests and are not tasked with personal dishwashing.

EARTHQUAKE PROCEDURE - In the unlikely event of a serious earthquake move to the emergency gathering identified in the fire evacuation notice in the room. If moving isn't safe, stand under the closest doorway until the earthquake stops, then proceed to the front of the property.

EXCESSIVE MESS - An additional cleaning charge will apply if your room is left in an unreasonable state

ELECTRIC BLANKETS - all beds are fitted with electric blankets. Cords may be tucked in over summer months

FIRE emergency instructions are located in your kitchen.

FIRST AID KIT is available from reception

HAIRDRYER - one hairdryer is supplied per unit. some units have an additional hairdryer in the wardrobe. We have spares so just ask if you need another.

HEATER and HEAT PUMP - please be courteous and turn these off when you leave the room. Electricity costs in Wanaka are high and your cooperation in conserving energy is appreciated.

EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW

HOUSEKEEPING - all rooms will be serviced upon request. Please put your "service my room" sign out before 12.00noon if you require a service. Pop into reception during opening hours to request additional towels, tea, coffee, toilet paper or other items.

IRON & IRONING BOARD are located in the wardrobe in your room. Pull to open.

KEYS - return your room keys to the drop box outside reception upon checkout. Unreturned keys will incur a \$100.00 charge

LAUNDRY - A laundry service is available for guests from 2pm daily. It is \$25.00 for a load to be washed, dried and returned to your room.

LOST & FOUND - Items left in rooms will be held for 1 week; thereafter, they'll be donated to charity. Postage for item return is at your expense

LUGGAGE STORAGE is available for motel guests. Please ask at reception

PARKING spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. There is free parking on the street outside the motel from 4pm - 9am.

RECYCLING - we are an eco friendly property. Please use the recycling bins provided for your paper, plastic, glass and cans

RETURNING GUESTS - Contact us directly via phone or email for the best rates on your next stay.



Places to HIKE

Wanaka Tree and Millennium Track

Easy - 5 mins+

From ASURE Brookvale Motel, it's just a 20-minute walk to the iconic Wanaka Tree along a scenic lakeside path. You can then continue on the Millennium Track, which follows the lake's edge and allows you to explore as far as you like, whether for a short stroll or a longer hike towards Glendhu Bay. Stop in at Edgewater Resort for a coffee and scone. You can also drive to the Wanaka Tree car park, which is a 5-minute walk from the tree.

Mount Iron

Easy/Medium Difficulty - Approx. 1-1.5 Hours Return - 250m Peak

This popular 4.5 km loop track offers stunning panoramic views of the surrounding lakes and mountains. Suitable for most fitness levels, it provides clear views of Lake Wanaka, the Southern Alps, and the township.

Diamond Lake

Medium Difficulty - 2-3 Hours Return - 775m Peak

This moderate 7.3 km hike features diverse landscapes, including lush forests and rocky terrain. Key highlights include the Diamond Lake Bird View and the panoramic Lake Wanaka viewpoint, making it a perfect spot for a picnic. For those seeking a shorter option, a leisurely stroll around Diamond Lake is available, offering beautiful scenery without the strenuous climb.

Grandview Mountain

Medium Difficulty - 4-6 Hours Return - 1,398m Peak

Experience breathtaking panoramic views over Lake Hawea and the surrounding peaks on this 18 km return hike. The trail features a gradual ascent along primarily a 4WD track and winds through diverse landscapes, including kānuka shrubland and beech forests. You will reach the summit at 1,398 meters, where stunning vistas of the Southern Alps and Lake Wanaka await.

Rob Roy Glacier Hike

Medium Difficulty - 3-4 Hours Return - 1080m Peak

Located in Mount Aspiring National Park (approximately 1 hour from ASURE Brookvale), this hike is a great day trip. The trail begins with a gentle ascent through lush beech forests and leads to stunning viewpoints of the glacier and surrounding peaks. As you approach the final lookout, you'll be rewarded with breathtaking vistas of the glacier tumbling down the mountainside.

Roys Peak

More Difficult - 4-6 Hours Return - 1,578m Peak

This iconic track is approximately 16 kilometers round trip and offers breathtaking views of Lake Wanaka and the surrounding mountains. We recommend starting early in the day, especially in summer, as it gets very hot. Be sure to take plenty of water and snacks.

Isthmus Peak

4-6 Hours Return - 1,384m Peak

The Isthmus Peak car park is about 30 minutes from ASURE Brookvale Motel. The hike offers panoramic views of Lake Wanaka and Lake Hawea. The trail begins with a steady climb through scenic farmland, leading you to the summit at 1,384 meters, where you'll be rewarded with panoramic vistas. The path is well-marked and suitable for hikers of moderate fitness levels, but be prepared for some steep sections. Don't forget to take plenty of water and snacks.

LOCAL Wineries & Breweries



MOUNT MAUDE TASTING ROOM

One of New Zealand's most scenic vineyards. Tastings are free but by appointment only—book online. Just a five-minute drive from ASURE Brookvale Motel, it offers breathtaking views of the area.



RIPPON

A family-owned winery renowned for its premium Central Otago wines, specializing in Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, and Riesling. The winery also offers stunning lake and mountain views and is just a five-minute drive.



PADDONS PADDOCK

Renowned for its handcrafted small-batch wines, including Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, and Rosé. Visitors can enjoy tastings in a rustic yet elegant setting with peaceful surroundings and stunning vineyard views. Just a five-minute drive.



BREW BAR

Located upstairs at 80 Ardmore Street, this lively taproom offers 16 beers on tap, NZ-sourced wines and spirits, and stunning Wānaka views from large windows and an outdoor balcony.



GROUND UP

Focused on crafting high-quality, small-batch beers with local ingredients, this brewery embraces sustainability and community. Brewing bold, audacious flavors on-site, they offer a diverse range, from IPAs to seasonal brews.
