Visitor Information Centre

The Geelong Tourist Information Centre is located in the National Wool Museum on the corner of Moorabool and Brougham streets.

The Great Ocean Road

Only an hour's drive from Melbourne, Geelong is Victoria's second largest city and the gateway to the incomparable Great Ocean Road.

Waterfront Geelong

One of the city's drawcards, Waterfront Geelong, features many cafes and restaurants, fully restored art deco seawater baths, Yacht club and a scenic bayside promenade dotted with brightly-painted bollards depicting many of Geelong's historical characters. Step back in time and take a ride on the fabulously restored 110 year old steam carousel by the waterfront and then continue to explore the many new attractions that surround beautiful Corio Bay.

The Bellarine Peninsula

The Bellarine Peninsula is home to a number of attractive beach towns including Queenscliff, Point Lonsdale, Drysdale, Ocean Grove, Barwon Heads, St Leonards and Portarlington. These popular tourist destinations are not only situated on a most attractive coastline, but have a number of interesting stops along the way. Attractions such as art and craft shops, markets and great eating establishments are also plentiful. The peninsula also boasts some of the best golf courses in Australia.

Within The Bellarine and adjacent Golden Plains Shire there are many wineries all waiting for you to discover and sample their award winning wines.

Geelong Otway Region

Every month there is something to see or do in the Geelong Otway region. Whether it's a sporting event, a fair, or a festival, there is always endless entertainment and something for everyone.

Apollo Bay

Little more than a decade ago, Apollo Bay was a sleepy coastal hamlet servicing local fishing, farming and timber milling communities. Today the township retains a low-key, friendly atmosphere as visitors discover the delights of the scenic bay, proximity to magnificent forests, waterfalls and walks. Promoted as "paradise by the sea", Apollo Bay offers a huge range of activities including surfing, swimming, bushwalking, easy strolling, Cape Otway lighthouse tours, picnicking, horse riding and golf. There are also museums, shipwreck sites, many plant nurseries and heritage trails.

National Wool Museum

The National Wool Museum has been revamped and takes us back to the historic wool years. The museum is a multimedia display that showcases the contribution of wool to Australia's growth.

Geelong Art Gallery

Included in the gallery's exhibitions are several paintings by Eugene Von Guerard which depict scenes of a time when Geelong as dependent upon the land for survival.

Buckley Falls

A short drive from the city is Buckley Falls. William Buckley, an escaped convict, lived with the local Koories for many years. They taught him to fish at these falls on the Barwon River and many years later he showed the new European settlers this fishing spot.

Guided Walks & Cycling

Walking and cycling paths hug the curve of the bay and provide easy access to the many attractions along the foreshore. More than 100 brightly-painted bollards are dotted around the bay depicting some of Geelong's local historic characters.
