- 1:30 pm : Guests arrival and shown to their seats by our team.
- 1:55 pm : Bride's arrival and greeted by our team.
- 2:00 pm : Wedding Ceremony.
- 2:30 pm : Drinks Reception with drinks and canapés served (if required) whilst your photographer arranges all your photo requirements inside the hotel and outside in the garden.
- 3:45 pm : Our Master of Ceremonies will invite your guests through to the dining room, to be seated for the Wedding Breakfast meal and then you'll be announced in to the room as the new Mr. and Mrs.
- 4:00 pm : If the speeches are before the meal, your selected Toast Drink is served and our MC will introduce the first speaker.
- 4:30 pm : Your selected wines are poured and the Wedding Breakfast Meal is served.
- 6:30 pm : Meal is finished, giving you and your guests the chance to freshen up before the Evening Reception. We will turn around the room and set up the tables and seating arrangements within 30 minutes which gives your Band or DJ time to set up their equipment.
- 7:15 pm : Evening guests arrival with drinks at the Bar.
- 7:45 pm : Formal cutting of the cake using our Claymore sword.
